COMMUNITY BENEFIT FUND NOW OPEN FOR APPLICATIONS

The Carraig Gheal Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund receives funds from the wind farm developer GreenPower (Carraig Gheal) Ltd. which is divided between the main grant scheme and the micro grant scheme.

There were 5 successful applications to the most recent round of funding for the main grant fund which ended in January covering projects throughout the five community council areas that surround the Carraig Gheal Wind Farm.

MAIN GRANT SCHEME – GRANTS FROM £501 - £7,000 (Village Halls up to £10,000)

The current funding round of the Carraig Gheal Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund main grant scheme is now open to constituted groups and completed applications must be submitted by 31st July 2021.

MICRO GRANT SCHEME – GRANTS UP TO £500*

The Micro Grant Scheme is open all year round and awards grants of up to £500 to individuals, constituted and non-constituted groups.

* Please note that the £500 limit for micro-grants is a temporary increase from £250 for the 2020/21 year and it should not be assumed this limit of £500 will be available in the future.
