**4TH GENERATION TERM CONTRACT FOR MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SCOTTISH TRUNK ROAD NETWORK – NORTH WEST UNIT
A85 PLANNED MAINTENANCE – CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING**

BEAR Scotland, on behalf of Transport Scotland are proposing to carry out essential carriageway resurfacing works on the A85 in Oban, located on Corran Esplanade. The works are programmed to commence on Sunday 16th January 2022 for approximately two weeks, with no work planned for Friday or Saturday nights.

To ensure the safety of both the workforce and members of the public, the Corran Esplanade will be closed for the full duration of the works. During which time, vehicles will be escorted under a 10mph convoy along George St. and Dunollie Rd. Access to Williams St. and Breadalbane St. via Corran Esplanade will be restricted during working hours. On street parking on Corran Esplanade will be prohibited for the full duration of the works. Please refer to the attached location plan for geographical clarity and the below table for a detailed breakdown of the planned works.

The working hours have been proposed overnight in order to minimise disruption to road users as far as reasonably possible whilst ensuring productivity. The loudest activities such as planing, and jackhammering will cease by 11pm each night. We would like to take this opportunity to thank motorists and residents for their patience in advance of these planned works.

The safety of maintenance workers remains a top priority during this project and strict physical distancing protocols, in line with Scottish Government guidance, will be in place to ensure all on-site personnel remain safe throughout the duration of the project. Robust risk assessments have been completed to ensure all staff are kept safe.
