**TERM CONTRACT FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SCOTTISH TRUNK ROAD NETWORK – NORTH WEST UNIT
A82 TYNDRUM FOOTWAY IMPROVEMENTS
CONSULTATION INFORMATION LETTER**

BEAR Scotland, on behalf of Transport Scotland, are proposing to undertake footway improvements on various sections of the A82 Trunk Road through Tyndrum, between Pine Trees Leisure Park and the Green Welly Stop. Please find attached location drawing for your information.

The works will include footway reconstruction and installation of dropped kerbs and tactile paving at the relevant pedestrian crossing points. The project is programmed for construction from Monday 13th September to Friday 29th October 2021. The works will be undertaken between 7am and 7pm each day, with no works currently planned for the weekends.

The road and footway will remain open. However, as a result of limited road widths through the sections, it will be necessary for a traffic management system incorporating temporary traffic signals with lane closures, and footway diversion, to be implemented to ensure the safety of our road workers, road users, cyclists and pedestrians.

Premises and residents within any closure will be permitted access during the works, although there may be times when this is restricted due to the nature of the works and to ensure the safety of our workforce and members of the public, which is of paramount importance. When access is restricted a member of the site team will contact those affected to advise of the specific arrangements and duration while the adjacent works are carried out.

Access through the works site for emergency services will be maintained at all times.
